



Introduction

Humans Net, Inc. ("Humans" or "We") respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website <http://humans.net> (our "Website") and use our "Humans.net" mobile application (collectively, the "Service") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:

- On the Service.
- In telephone calls, email, text, and other electronic messages between you and Humans.
- From offline activities and communications.

It does not apply to information collected by:

Children Under the Age of 13

Information We Collect from You and Purpose of Collection

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Service, including information:

- by which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number (landline or cellular), credit card information, personal banking account information and any other information the Service collects that is defined as personal or personally identifiable information under an applicable law ("personal information"); and/or
- about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Service and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the Service. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties, for example, our business partners, including, without limitation, Assembly, if such information is provided to us.

Information You Provide to Us:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Service. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our Service, accepting the [Terms of Use](#) in order to the services provided by Humans through use of the Service, posting material, using our chat or other messenger functionality or requesting further services or creating a profile.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies.

As you navigate through and interact with our Service, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Service, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Service.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information we collect automatically is statistical data and does not include personal information, but we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our Service and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:
